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### WORK WEEK

This full-time position work week is 40 hours, 8 hours a day, 5 days a week. A work week begins on Wednesday at 12:01 a.m. and ends on the following Tuesday at 11:59 p.m. A normal workday is from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. with a one-half hour lunch period each day.

### DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK

This is semi-skilled work involving application of various mosquito control techniques. The work involves larviciding and adulticiding operations. Work is performed under the general supervision of the mosquito control Operations Coordinator. This is an entry level training position involving all aspects of mosquito control.

### PRIMARY JOB DUTIES

- ◆ Submit a complete and accurate daily report.
- ◆ Learn to identify mosquitoes and mosquito larva.
- ◆ Application of pesticides for mosquito control.
- ◆ Assist in conducting field studies to determine mosquito breeding sites.
- ◆ Ensure equipment is properly serviced and ready for use.
- ◆ Perform minor maintenance as required.
- ◆ Become knowledgeable in adulticiding principles and practices. Able to adulticide for mosquitoes at night or early in the morning, as need arises.
- ◆ Pick up mosquito trap collections and maintain trap sites.
- ◆ Assist in the arbovirus surveillance activities & maintenance of coop sites & sentinel birds.
- ◆ Perform related work as required.

- ◆ Learn all aspects of operational activities through on the job training.

**KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES**

- ◆ Understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- ◆ Knowledge of principles and practices of mosquito control in keeping with the mosquito control problems inherent to the area.
- ◆ Recognize safety hazards in the workplace and take precautionary measures to protect self and others.
- ◆ Establish and maintain effective working relationship with co-workers, supervisors, and the general public.
- ◆ Inspect citizen complaints or service requests in a courteous, professional manner.
- ◆ Physically capable of performing assigned duties and work outdoors, occasionally under adverse weather conditions.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- ◆ High School Diploma or equivalent GED.
- ◆ Possession of a valid Florida Driver's License and insurable.
- ◆ Must be able to obtain the Public Health Certification as issued by the Florida Department of Agriculture within the probationary period of employment.
